- The Cost of Attendance (COA) includes the UC Student Health Insurance Plan (SHIP) of \$3,855. Students may opt out of the UC Student Health Insurance Plan. For additional UC SHIP information, visit https://shwadmin.ucsd.edu/uc-ship/index.html.
- Non-California resident and international students are not charged a Non-Resident Supplemental Tuition cost. Non-California residents will be considered for federal aid only: <u>Federal Direct Loans</u>. International students will also be billed a one-time <u>International Student Visa Administration fee</u> of \$100. International students may apply for <u>Private Education</u> Loans to assist with educational costs.
- The Cost of Attendance (COA) includes the GPS Professional Degree Supplemental Tuition of \$9,795 for California Residents and Non-California Residents.
- Students may submit <u>Cost of Attendance Add-On forms</u> with appropriate documentation for rent and utilities, transportation costs, computer purchases and/or increased books and supplies. <u>Submission of a request does not guarantee an approval.</u>
- Financial Aid and Scholarships Office provides <u>Federal Direct Unsubsidized and Federal Direct Graduate PLUS Loans</u> and requires the <u>Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)</u>. <u>Private Education Loans</u> are available for domestic and international students. Inquire at the Financial Aid and Scholarships Office for lenders that accept international applicants. Your Major Department and/or the <u>Graduate Division</u> may provide other forms of financial support. School of Global Policy & Strategy <u>Fellowships & Financing</u> and <u>Military & Families</u>. You may be required to complete and submit the FAFSA to be considered for some types of graduate awards. FAFSAs are available beginning October 1st every year.
- Students who are unable to complete the FAFSA and/or California Dream Act Application or who are enrolled in less than half-time (6 units), may be able to apply for a private loan. Private Education Loans are available for domestic and international students. Inquire at the Financial Aid and Scholarships Office for lenders that accept international applicants.
- GPS Full-Time MIA Program students pay \$17,385 tuition and fees. The 24-month GPS Full-Time MIA Program requires 96 units for completion.
