- Non-California resident and international students pay Non-Resident Supplemental Tuition (currently estimated to be \$15,102 annually) in addition to charges paid by California resident students. To assist with educational costs, Non-California residents will be considered for federal aid only: [Federal Pell Grant](#), [Federal Work-Study](#) and [Federal Direct loans](#). International students will also be billed a one-time [International Student Visa Administration fee](#) of \$100. International students may apply for [Private Education Loans](#), to assist with educational costs.

Students enrolled the School of Global Policy and Strategy (GPS), Rady School of Management, Joint Ed.D (UCSD/CSUSM) and other self-supporting professional degree programs will have different [fees](#) and budget costs.
